Minutes of City of Burkesville Council Meeting

July 20th, 2017

The Burkesville City Council held its monthly meeting July 20th, 2017, at City Hall. Roll call was taken, those present were as follows: Councilpersons Billy Guffey, Terry Murphy, Glen Murphy and Lana Owens. Absent: Councilperson Odis Young and Billy Maxey. Others present were as follows: Mayor Keith Riddle, City Clerk Brenda Spears, Chief of Police Brad Perdue, Assistant Chief of Police Lawrence Nettles, Police Officer Wesley Long, Water/Wastewater Superintendent Ed Peretto, Assistant Water Superintendent Doug Radford, Employee Joe Appleby, Employee Chris Garvey, Park Director David McIntyre, City Attorney Angie Capps, Cumberland County News Cindy Pritchett and Pastor Dana Coverstone.

Councilperson Glen Murphy made a motion to approve the June 15th, 2017 minutes, seconded by Councilperson Terry Murphy. All in favor none opposed. Mayor Riddle declared the motion approved.

Council discussed Profit and Loss, Over Time and Check Register for the month of June 2017 for each department. Councilperson Terry Murphy made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilperson Billy Guffey. All in favor none opposed. Mayor Riddle declared the motion approved.

Councilperson Terry Murphy made a motion to approve Park request on October 21st, 2017, for a birthday party at Log Cabin, seconded by Councilperson Lana Owens. All in favor none opposed. Mayor Riddle declared the motion approved.

Councilperson Billy Guffey made a motion to approve Park request on September 23rd, 2017, for project graduation, seconded by Councilperson Lana Owens. All in favor none opposed. Mayor Riddle declared the motion approved.

Councilperson Billy Guffey made a motion to approve Park request on September 9th, 2017, for Kosair Charity, seconded by Councilperson Glen Murphy. All in favor none opposed. Mayor Riddle declared the motion approved.

Mayor Riddle presented Council with Municipal Order 2017-7 AMENDED ORDER ESTABLISHING POSITION SPECIFICATIONS FOR PERSONNEL POSITIONS FOR THE CITY OF BURKESVILLE KENTUCKY. Councilperson Terry Murphy made a motion to approve Municipal Order 2017-7, seconded by Councilperson Glen Murphy. All in favor none opposed. Mayor Riddle declared the motion approved.

Councilperson Glen Murphy made a motion to approve Resolution 2017-1 in support for changes in the KRS retirement, seconded by Councilperson Billy Guffey. All in favor none opposed. Mayor Riddle declared the motion approved.



Park Director David McIntyre informed council with a print out how the Southern Kentucky Classic did and stating it done a little better than last year.


